

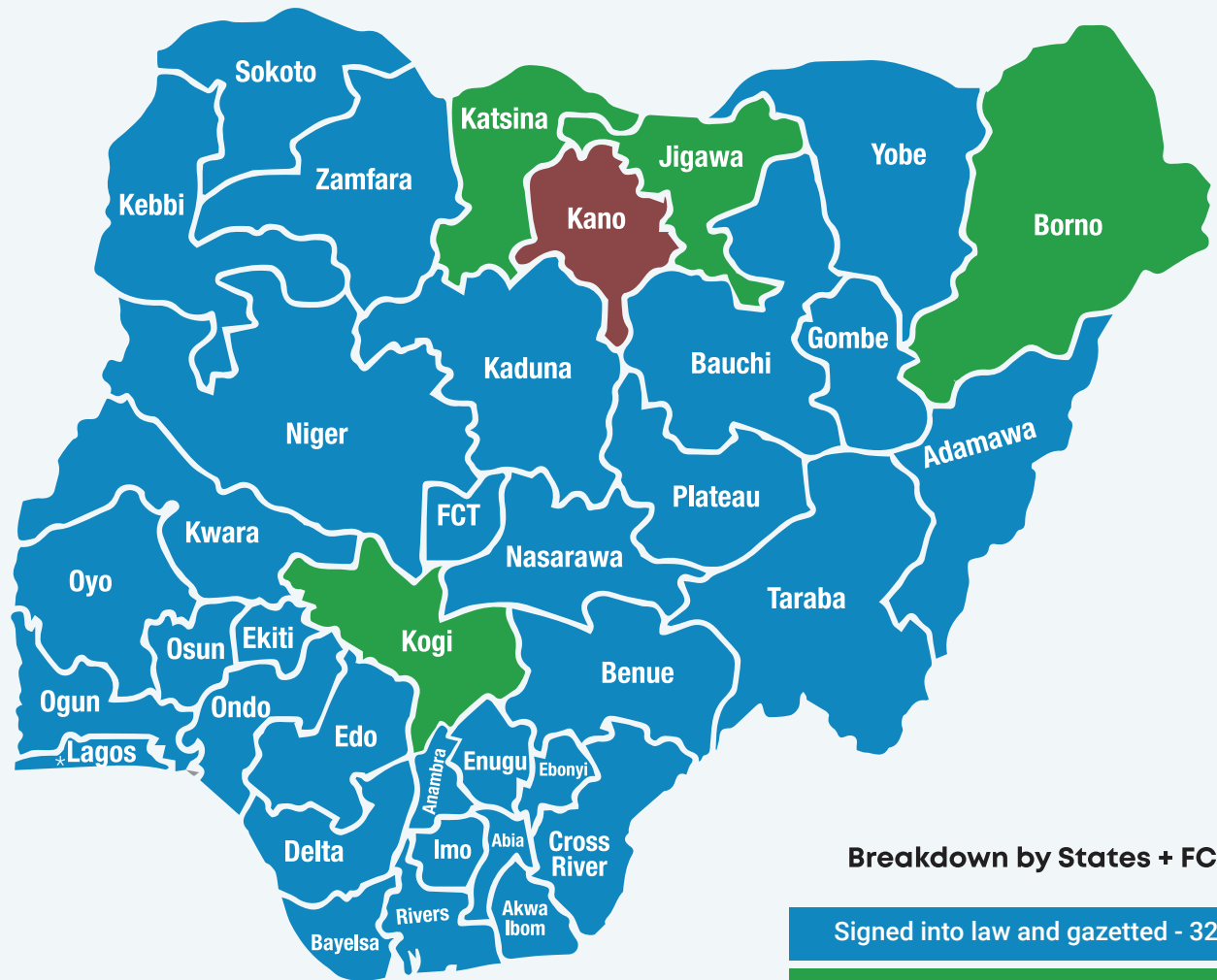


The Violence Against Persons Prohibition (VAPP Act) 2015
